Old Scratch Amber Lager Frederick, MD A malty, mellow beer that is fermented at medium temperatures to develop both ale and lager characteristics.

Magic Hat #9 Burlington, VT Dry, crisp, fruity, refreshing, not-quite pale ale. #9 is really impossible to describe because there's never been anything else quite like it.

Victory Prima Pils Downington, PA Heaps o' hops are hiding under the full, frothy head of this elegant Pils. All German malt subtleties linger beneath and long dry finish of this classy quencher.

Great Divide Titan IPA Denver, CO Beginning with piney hop aromas and citrus hop flavors, and finishing with a rich, malty sweetness that is carefully balanced with crisp hop bitterness.

Rogue American Amber Ale Placeville, CA Tawny in color, with a coffee aroma, tight head and a delicate roasted malt accent.

Ithaca Apricot Wheat Ithaca, NY Easy drinking wheat beer that is light in color and body. A hint of apricot gives this beer a pleasant nose and fruity finish.

Ithaca Pale Ale Ithaca, NY A deep golden colored ale with a balanced taste from its bitter west coast hops and sweet malts.

Ithaca Nut Brown Ithaca, NY Smooth and moderate dark ale with subtle hints of both chocolate & coffee beneath it's rich mahogany hue.

Keegan Ales Mother's Milk Kingston, NY A smooth and silky stout that is dark in color and creamy in texture. Hints of oatmeal and chocolate.

Keegan Ales Old Capital Kingston, NY Simply a golden, crisp and refreshing beer.

Ommegang Abbey, Cooperston, NY This burgundian brew gives off a variety of aromas, including plum and cinnamon, and packs in flavors such as caramel, toffee, and licorice.

Pork Slap ~ Pale Ale The beer is flavored with crystal hop and a touch of fresh ginger to create a distinct flavor. Good ale flavor and a crisp mild finish.

Snapperhead ~ IPA It's every bit as rich but a little less bitter than other American interpretations of the breed. It shows its sweet side first then brings out the bitter hop in the end.

Moo Thunder ~ Stout A more drinkable version of the Stout breed. It has a malty, roasty aroma and a dry finish.

Heinnieweisse ~ Weissebier Rich, fully fresh palate. Pour it and see the wheat cloudiness, smell the notes of estery aroma. You'll taste the effervescent, sweet yet tart freshness.

Malbec (Argentina) - Bouquet swirls with heady aromas of black cherries, chocolate and garrigue. Medium to full bodied with fine tannins and a lingering, complex finish. Complements grilled meats, rosemary, garlic and fennel dishes.

Rose (Spain) - A medium-bodied wine with a bouquet of ripe strawberries, tangerines, and melon. Fine acidity with peach and mineral undertones. Great with grilled fish, shellfish, and vegetables.

Torrontes (Argentina) - Expansive and fresh aromas of peach, cantaloupe and pineapple, with a hint of lime. Fresh and lively, with medium weight, nice acidity, and a long fruit and mineral laden finish. Complements smoked meats, mild to medium-strong cheeses, seafood and spicy foods.

Sauvignon Blanc (Chile) - Mandarin orange, key lime and tangerine aroma. Medium weight, bright acidity with lingering flavors of Lime, Peach and Minerals. Good with Grilled fish, cheeses, grilled vegetables and cured meats.

Pinot Grigio 2009 - Clean, intense aroma and the dry flavor with pleasant citrine aftertaste make this a wine of character and versatility. Ideal accompaniment to seafood salads, fish and shellfish based pasta and rice courses. Perfect with white

Botter Prosecco - A sparkling white, it has a delicate aromatic bouquet of white flowers, honey and apples, with a beautifully balanced light body.

Wyatt Wines California

Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 - Combination of bright, crisp component from Mendocino for structure and acidity, with a slightly broader and rounded component from Clarksburg for mouth feel and texture. This wine is clean, bright, ample, and apple-y, sort of like a California style Macon.

Wyatt Chardonnay 2009 - Beautiful pure notes of melons, crisp orange rind and a slight honeysuckle note are present in this medium-bodied, deliciously fresh, fruit-driven but stylish Chardonnay with no wood.
